### A YEAR OF TRANSFORMATIVE IMPACT

Our beloved K-9 for Kids program, with its trained AKC-recognized Canine Good Citizens dogs, offered a calming presence to more than 2,900 youth and adults at our events, in juvenile detention centers, and during our Annual Holiday Toy Shop. In total, you provided life-changing advocacy and mentorship to 765 children, youth, and families in 2025.

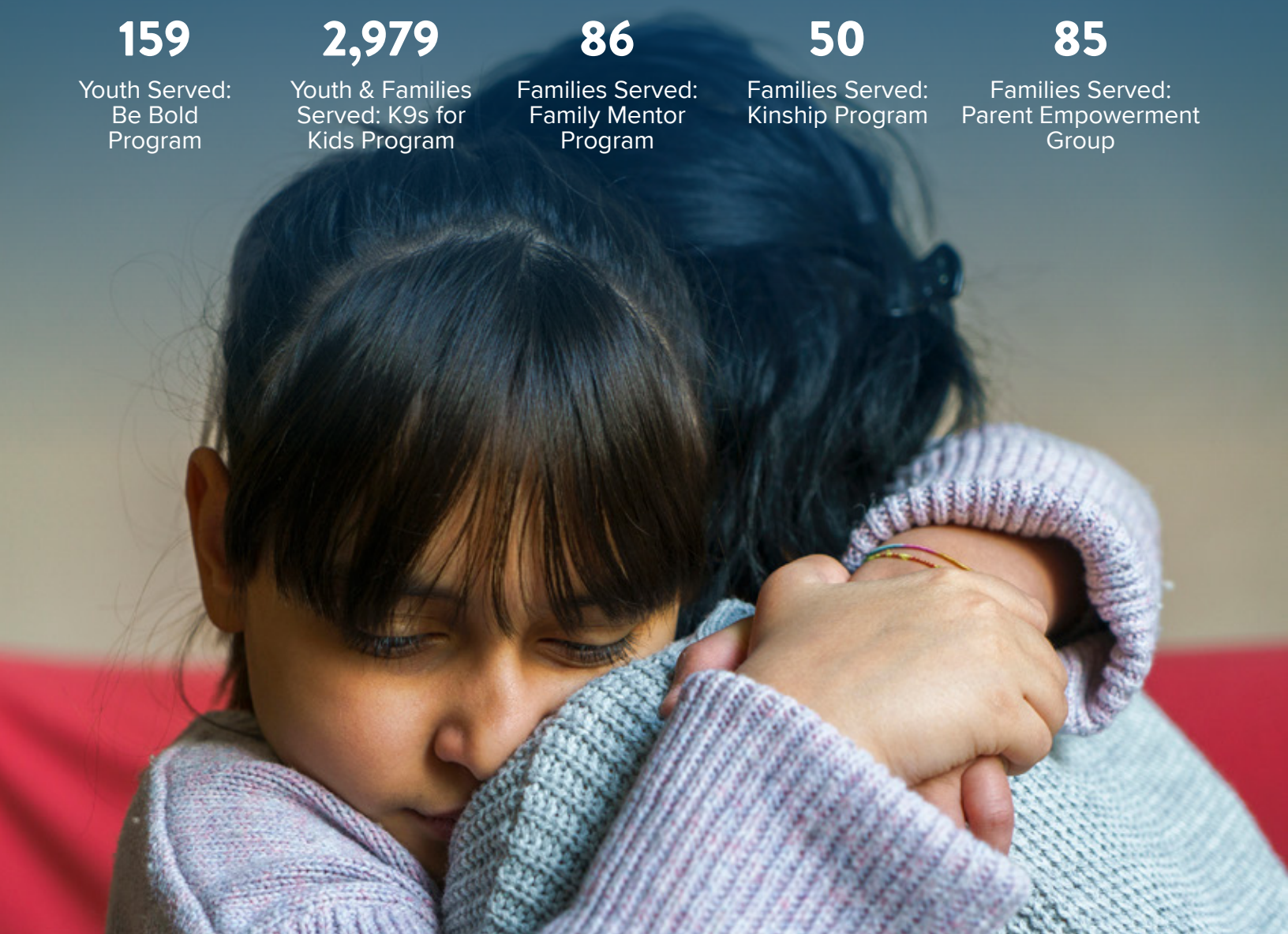

# CASA & BE BOLD SPOTLIGHT



## FINDING THEIR VOICE

When siblings were removed from their home, their seven-year-old sister had never been able to communicate with the world around her. Growing up in a home where disabilities were hidden, she had spent her life in silence. Everything changed when the children were placed with resource parents who used American Sign Language — and when a CASA volunteer stepped up, enrolled in ASL classes, and began advocating for her in a language she could finally understand. For the first time, she could share her thoughts, her feelings, her dreams. She could speak up in court hearings, where she now expresses gratitude every time for finally having a voice. Through our K9s 4 Kids program, she lit up meeting Kona and Harley — laughing, clapping, running to greet them alongside her brother. Today, both children are reunited with their mother, who is learning ASL to continue supporting her daughter's journey. What began as silence became connection, empowerment, and healing.

For Ellie, a participant in our Be Bold mentoring program, the silence was a different kind. When her mentor first met her nearly four years ago, she was eight years old and her family was in crisis. Through divorce, shifting family dynamics, struggles at school, and ruptures in friendships, her mentor showed up every single week — visiting museums, taking walks, attending *The Nutcracker* each winter, and practicing coping tools together. When Ellie shared something painful, she used to end with “I’m fine, it’s fine.” Gently, patiently, her mentor reminded her that her feelings were real and worth hearing. Recently, after a hard day, Ellie went for a walk, talked openly about a struggle at home, and didn’t end with “I’m fine.” Instead, she talked about how she planned to share her feelings with her dad. It was a small moment that held something enormous: a child learning to trust herself.

# FAMILY SERVICES SPOTLIGHT

**Mary left her home state to keep three generations together. Nancy boarded a plane so Sara wouldn't walk into court by herself. Two families, two different crises, one shared belief that carries our whole-family approach.**

## WHEN FAMILIES NEED SOMEONE TO SHOW UP

Mary didn't hesitate when her daughter Jessica's mental health crisis led to child welfare intervention — she packed up her life and moved from out of state to keep her grandchildren out of foster care. But stepping in came with its own challenges. Living with physical disabilities and unable to work, Mary faced an eviction notice on top of everything else. Our team wrapped around the whole family: a Kinship mentor helped Mary secure new housing, a reunification mentor supported Jessica, and CASA volunteers advocated for the children. Today, Jessica has moved back in, the children are in school, and three generations are home together.

Nancy Taylor, a retired therapist who joined us in 2023, brought that same spirit to her match with Sara — a mother in Acres of Hope who was homeless, separated from her newborn, and navigating a child welfare case more than 500 miles away. Nancy showed up week after week: grocery runs, court hearings, CFT meetings, coping skills, and steady encouragement. When a critical hearing was scheduled in Riverside County, she flew there on her own time and at her own expense, simply

because Sara needed someone beside her. Sara regained custody of her youngest daughter. The two remain connected to this day.

**Two families. Two very different paths through crisis. And running through both of them, the same thread: someone who refused to let them face it alone.**

**This is what the whole-family approach makes possible. This is what it looks like when a community decides that no one gets left behind.**

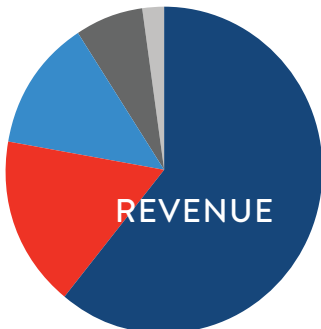

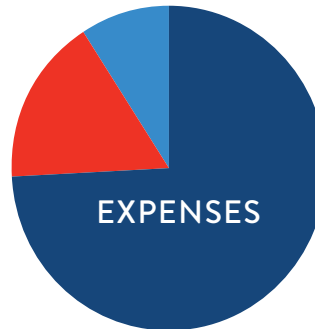
